Self-Certification

Homeschooled students are eligible to receive federal aid funds if their secondary school education was complete in a homeschool that state law treats as a home or a private school. The homeschool program must be equivalent to the requirements of a high school diploma. Some states issue a secondary school completion credential to homeschoolers. If this is the case in the state where the student was homeschooled, he or she must have obtained this credential in order to be eligible for federal aid funds.
