

Children's Minister Job Description

Position: The Children's Minister provides leadership and oversight to the Children's Ministry program (birth-5th grade).

Primary Responsibilities:

- 1. Develop a clearly defined vision and strategy for discipleship within the Children's Ministry that works in conjunction with the overall vision and ministry of RBCC.
- 2. Lead, recruit, train and develop volunteers for the Children's Ministry.
- 3. Assist in building, developing and training the Step Forward Leadership Team, which consists of committed junior and senior high school students. Provide them service opportunities in the Children's Ministry.
- 4. In coordination with the Student Minister, develop and implement strategy for whole-family discipleship; working with families to equip and empower parents/families to disciple and train their children.
- 5. Provide oversight and planning for all aspects of Children's Ministry programming, including:
 - Sunday morning Kidzone and Littles classes
 - Wednesday night programming Brushfire
 - Specialized classes/events Becoming a Jesus Follower class, Big Overnighter at Oil Belt, etc.
 - Outreach groups/events Trunk or Treat, school events, Fall Festival, etc.
 - Family events Baby dedication, Christmas program, etc.
 - Summer events July Jam, Oil Belt Camp, etc.
 - Curriculum selection/development for all programming.
 - Serve on the Kingdom Workers Scholarship team.
 - Communication with students and parents including hospital visits, home visits, texts and phone calls, etc.
 - Maintain the classrooms cleaning, organizing, stocking supplies, etc.
- 6. Oversee safety measures for our students organize background checks, check equipment in classrooms and playground areas, etc.

Secondary Responsibilities:

- 1. Work with the rest of the ministerial and support staff. This includes making every effort to attend all staff functions.
- 2. Participate and provide support and leadership (when necessary) in church-wide events, even if they do not directly affect the Children's Ministry.
- 3. Provide oversight to the Children's Ministry budget.

General Expectations:

- 1. Expected to be a positive influence in the church; being a Jesus follower, living the Christian life, being a prayer warrior, being a light in the community and putting others before self.
- 2. Expected to work 40+ hours per week.
- 3. Expected to follow the staff handbook.
- 4. Expected to be organized and effective.
- 5. Expected to have a strong work ethic, being diligent in all facets of ministry.
